## Immersion Sound Chair by Samuelson Furniture

While Samuelson Furniture has been around for more than 90 years, the fourth-generation family brand made some noise during its CES debut with its Immersion Sound Chair. As the name suggests, it fuses ergonomic seating with Bluetooth audio, and while it's not the first product to do this, it delivers private sound to those who sit in it (and unlike most gaming chairs, it's not a directional firing speaker). Designed primarily for aging adults, the company says, the high-back wing solid wood chair, finished in a walnut stain, is meant to "reduce hearing strain while supporting music therapy, relaxation, and cognitive wellness." The patented Immersion Sound Chair is now available for \$8,750.
