

Ageless Living Collaborative Announces First Senior Living Design Scholarship Recipient

The ALC Scholarship offers support to students interested in pursuing senior living design.

The Ageless Living Collaborative (ALC) has announced the recipient of its first Ageless Living Collaborative Senior Living Design Scholarship. Offered specifically to students interested in pursuing senior living design, the scholarship provides \$10,000 to be used for tuition against the recipient's current studies.

Mashika Gallo, a graduate student in Healthcare Design and Gerontology at Kent State University (Ohio), will be the first to receive the scholarship and is to be honored at an official ceremony and presentation that will take place at the Gold Key Awards, November 14, 2022, during the BDNY show.

"I am so thankful that Ageless Living Collaborative has awarded me the very first ALC Senior Living Scholarship. It will allow me to complete my final semester in obtaining my master's degree in Healthcare Design and graduate certificate in Gerontology," said Gallo.

"Design is one of the ways I can use my voice to advocate for the senior community- by designing functional, accessible, and inclusive spaces that exemplifies the importance of seniors in our society, supports the quality of life they deserve, and reflects my belief in the power of wholeness, sense of agency, and community."
